Course and Certificate Guide

All state team members seeking selection onto the NSW State Team are required to have completed the following prerequisites to be considered for selection onto the NSW State Team. These are required to be completed with the relevant certificates uploaded when completing the State Team Nomination Form.

Gymnastics NSW has a no tolerance stand to drugs in sport. Gymnastics Australia has informed all states that Sport Integrity Australia will be present at the Australian Championships and will be performing drug testing throughout the event. All gymnasts competing at an international and national level at the Australian Championships are subject to anti-doping compliance and obligations and may be tested.

In order to ensure that all team members including gymnasts, coaches and officials are prepared for the possibility of being drug tested, as well as are aware of their rights and responsibilities surrounding drug testing, Gymnastics NSW requires each state team member to complete the online "[Anti-Doping Fundamentals](#)". If this has been previously completed as a State Team member this does not need to be repeated. Each state team member is also required to complete the "[Annual Update 2025](#)". The Annual Update course is required to be completed each year.

Please note: There may be a slight delay when completing one course and being able to enrol in the next course. If you experience this, please wait 15-30 mins while the system updates and then try again.




1. Go to <https://elearning.sportintegrity.gov.au/login/index.php>



2. Log in or Register
 - a. When registering and completing these courses, please ensure they are completed in the state team member name (e.g. gymnast name, not parent name)
3. From here you can either search for the course name or use the links about and in the State Team Circular
4. Complete the required courses
5. Once all required courses have been completed (2 for Gymnasts, 4 for Officials) you will need to download your certificate
6. At the top of the page you will see "Download Certificate"



7. Click "Download Certificate"




1. Click on the sign in link at the top of any Gymnastics Australia or State Gymnastics Association website.
2. You will be taken to a [sign in page](#).




3. You will be taken to your My Account page.

The Flex button is located to the top right of the screen.




The Flex Learning Management System will open in a new tab on your browser.
